

## AAT Mobile (iOS) User Guide

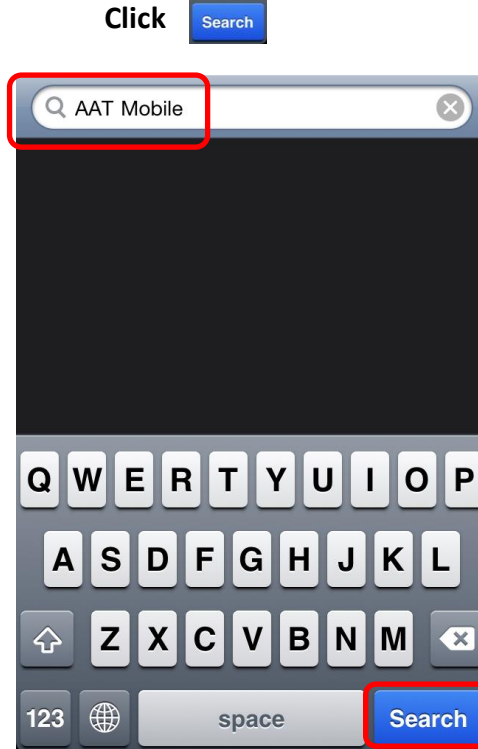
### How to download

1) By searching "AAT Mobile" in App Store, you can download and install the application on your iPhone® **free of charge**.

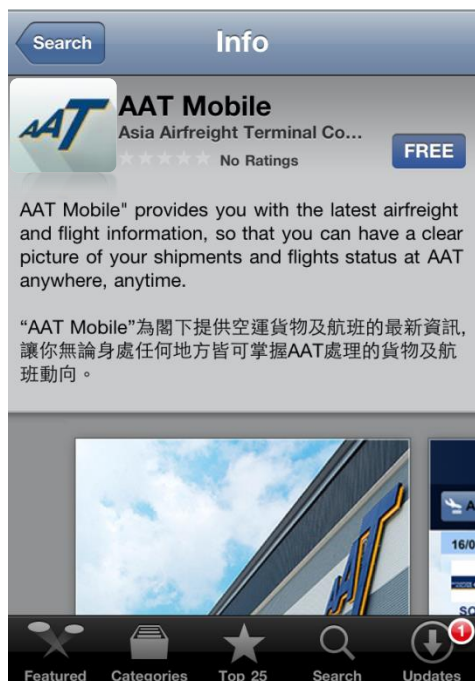
**Step 1: Open App Store**



**Step 2: Type "AAT Mobile" and Click**



**Step 3: Click** **FREE** **to download**



**Step 4: "AAT Mobile" is installed**



## How to Use

1) A welcome page will be shown when you click



### (A) Flight Schedule

“Flight Schedule” allows you to check Arrival and Departure flight schedule of “Yesterday”, “Today” and “Tomorrow”. For example, if today is 24/04/2015, users would then be able to check flight from 23/04/2015 to 25/04/2015.

You can search the flight schedule using “Flight No.”, “Airline”, “Origin/Destination”

You can click the “Refresh” button to get the updated flight schedule information.

You can click “Arrival” / “Departure” to check the schedule for Arrival / Departure Flight.

## **(B) Air Waybill**

“Air Waybill” allows you to check the status of your Import or Export shipment.

### **1) AWB Summary**

In order to view the updated information of a shipment, you need to register a valid 11-digit AWB number in “AWB Summary” page.

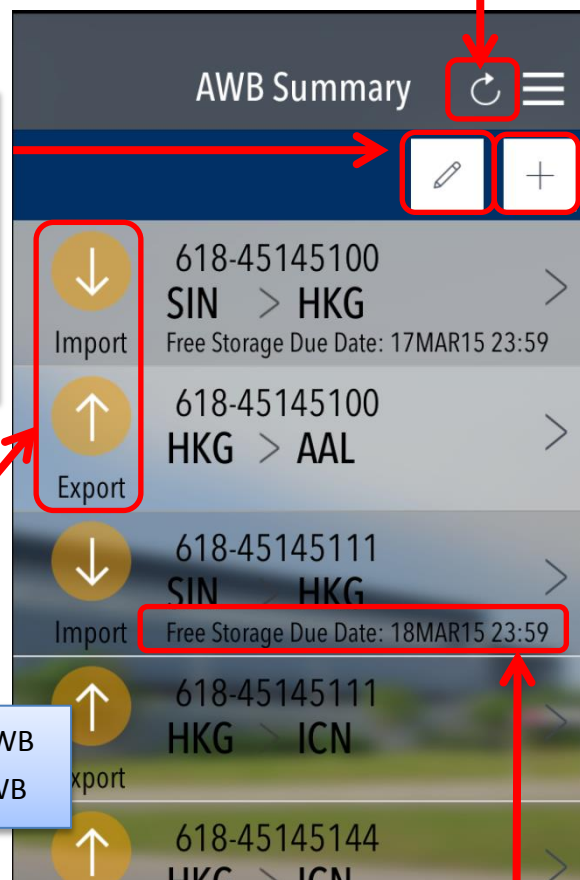
You can click the “Refresh” button to get the updated AWB information.

You can click here to delete selected records or all AWB Summary records.

You can click “+” to register a new AWB by entering valid 11-digit AWB number (a maximum of 10 AWBs can be registered).

“IMPORT” = Import AWB  
“EXPORT” = Export AWB

“Automatic Free Storage Period Calculation” would be shown for Import shipment.

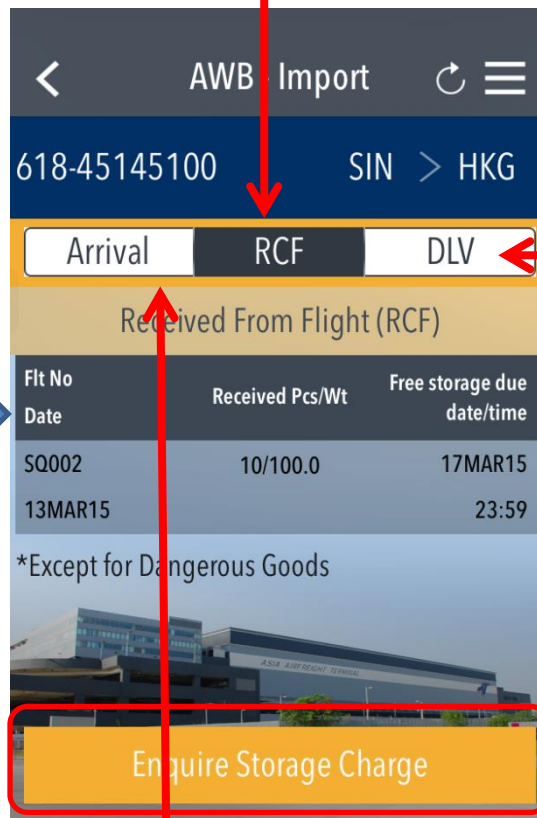
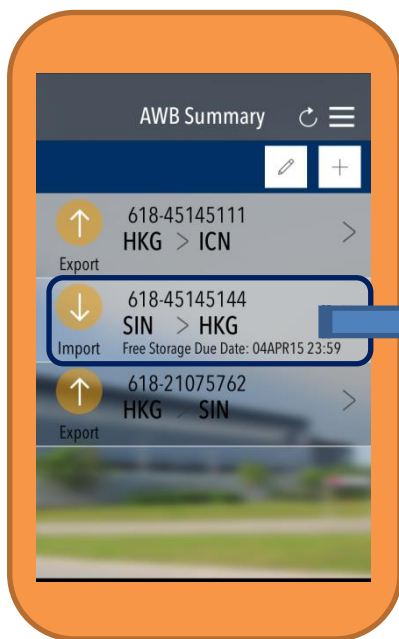


## 2) AWB – Import

In the “AWB – Import” page, Arrival Information, Received From Flight (RCF) and Cargo Delivered (DLV) information will be shown.

### Received From Flight (RCF)

RCF shows the details of shipment AAT received from arrival flight after breakdown process. It shows the arrival flight number and date, the received pieces and weight of shipment found after breakdown, and the relevant date and time.



### Cargo Delivered (DLV)

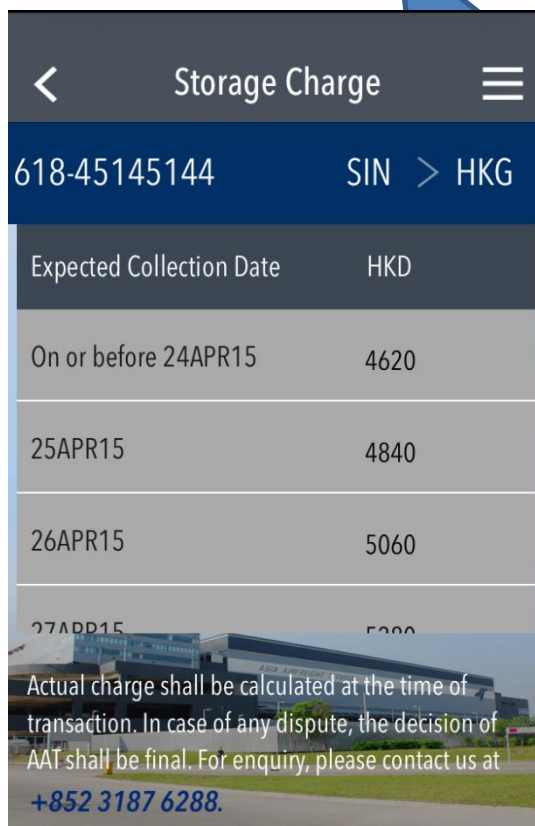
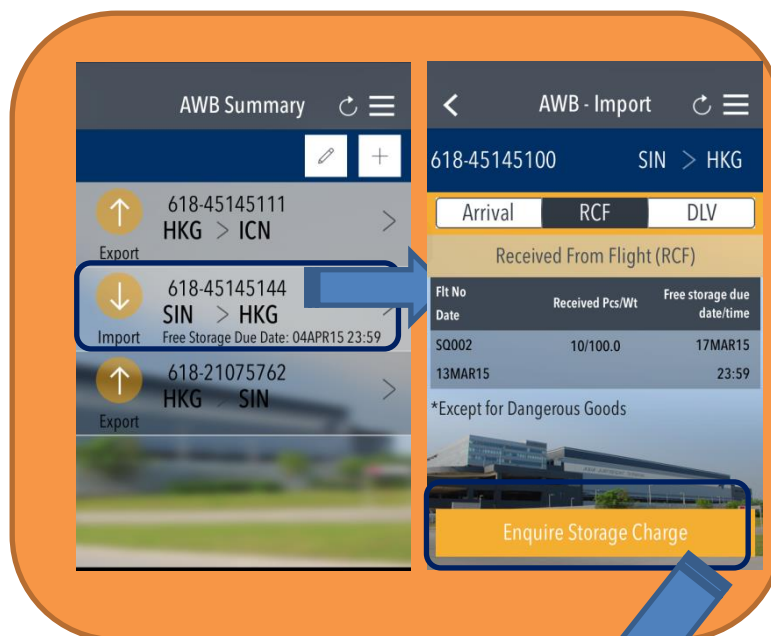
DLV shows the details of shipment which is delivered to consignee. It shows the delivery date and time, and the pieces and weight of shipment delivered.

### Arrival Information (Arrival)

Arrival Information shows the details of arrival flight that the shipment is assigned. It shows the arrival flight number and date, STA, ATA, Manifest Pieces and Weight of Shipment assigned of that flight.

## 3) AWB – Import – Enquire Storage Charge

“Storage Charge” will appear once shipment is ready for collection after clicking “Enquire Storage Charge”.



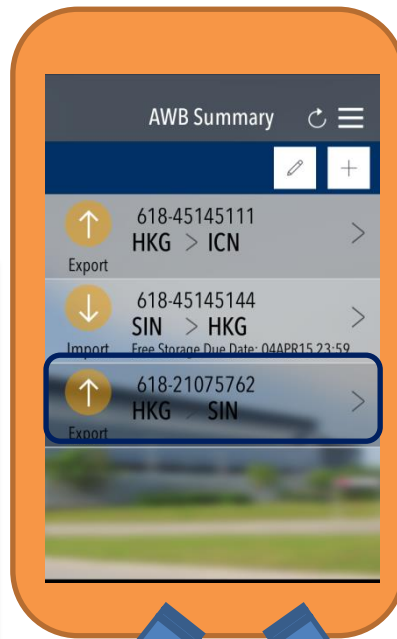


## 4) AWB – Export

In the “AWB – Export” page, Received From Shipper (RCS) and Departure Flight (DEP) information will be shown.

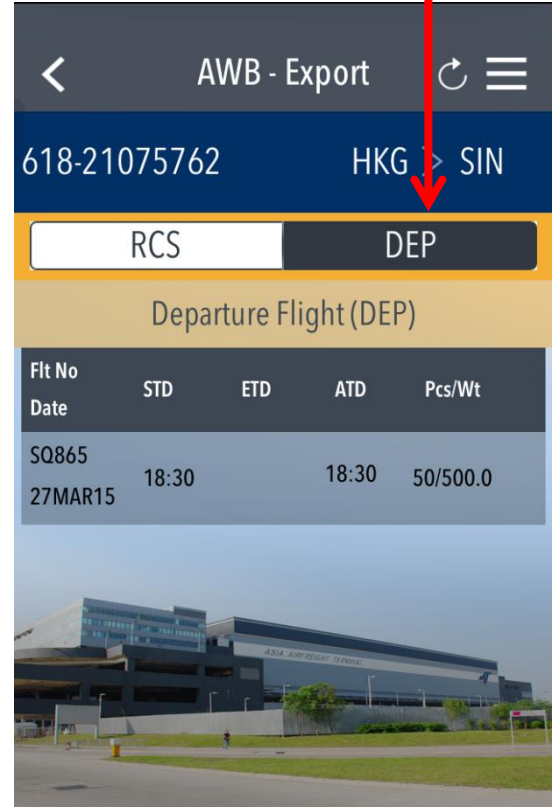
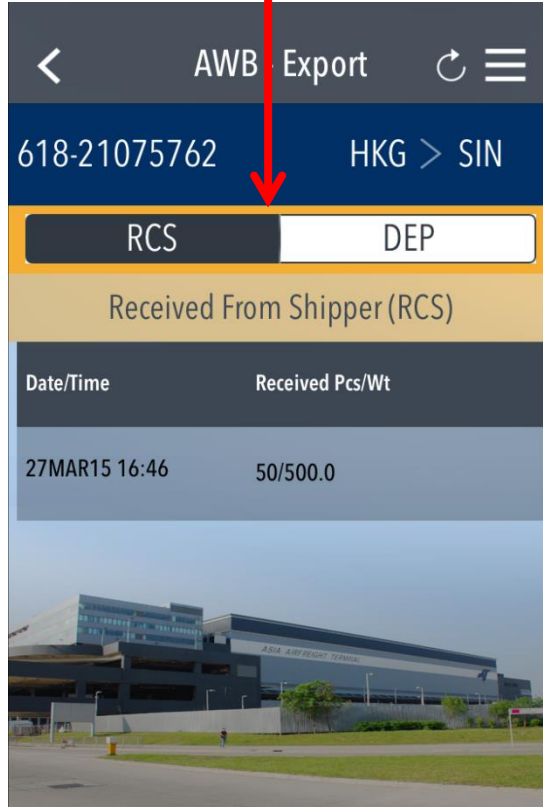
### Received From Shipper (RCS)

RCS is the information regarding both shipment and AWB documents are delivered to AAT. It shows the date and time, pieces and weight of shipment that shippers delivered to AAT.



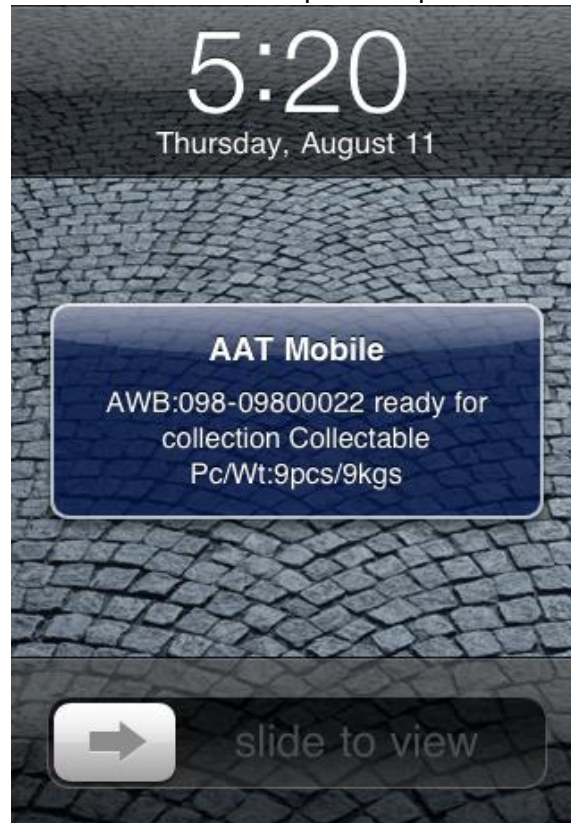
### Departure Flight (DEP)

DEP is the information regarding the assigned flight for a shipment departed. It shows the flight number, departure date, STD, ETD, ATD of the assigned flight, pieces and weight of the shipment assigned to that flight.



### 5) AWB – Reminder Notification

“Reminder Notification” will pop up once shipment is ready for collection. Information of AWB no. associated with shipments’ pieces and weight will be shown.



In order to receive “Reminder Notification”, you need to turn on the Notification Setting of AAT Mobile.

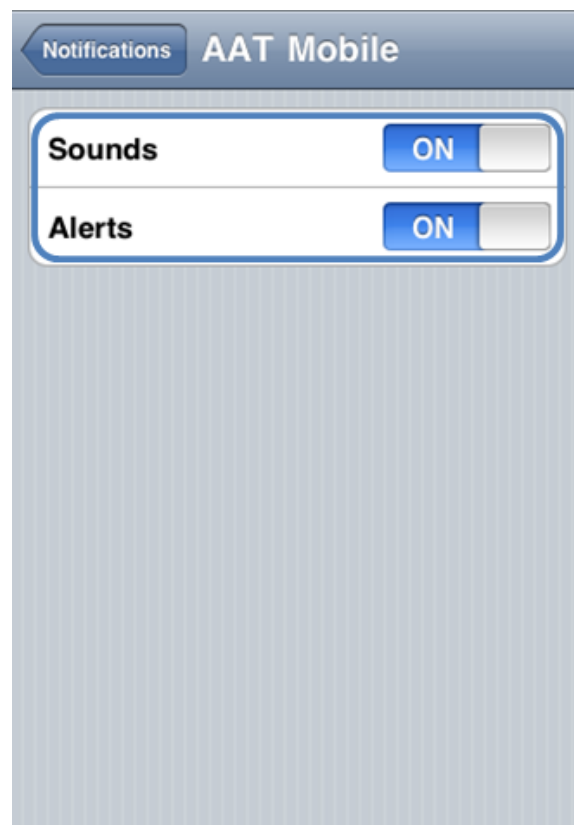
#### Step 1: Turn on the Notifications in iPhone® Settings

## Step 3: Turn on “Sounds” and “Alerts” notifications



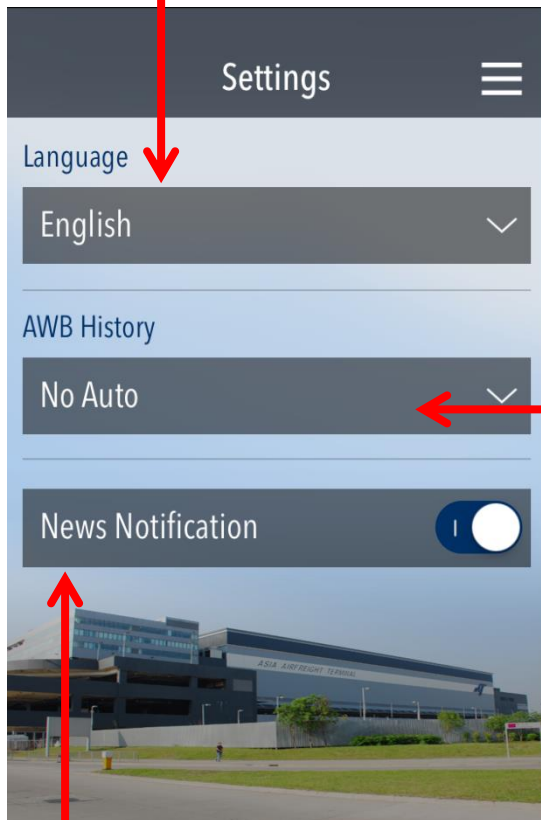


### **(C) Settings**

Settings page include three functions: 1) Language 2) AWB History and 3) News Notification.

#### **Language**

You can choose from “English”, “Traditional Chinese” & “Simplified Chinese”.



#### **AWB History**

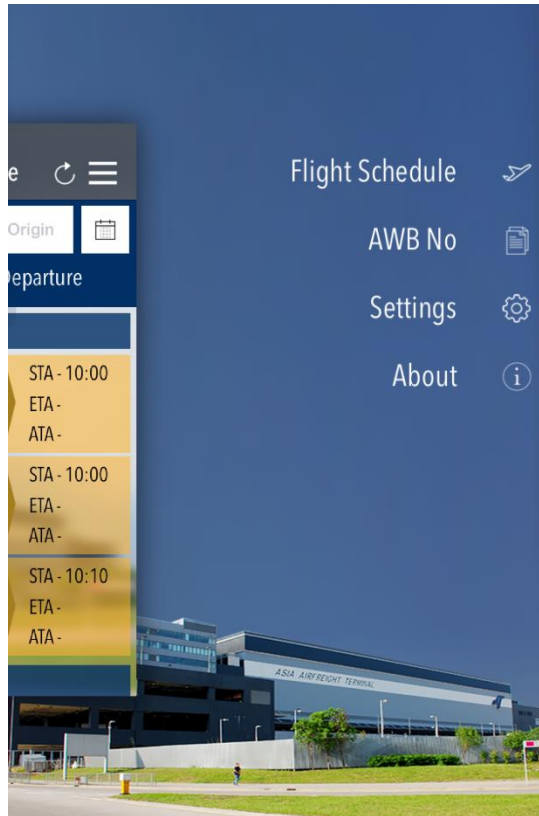
To manage your shipment enquiry record easily, you can choose how long you would like the Registered AWB Record to be kept. The default setting would be “No Auto Clearance of AWB Record” and the AWB record would be kept for 2 months in your iPhone® device, starting from the date of registration. You can choose from 1 / 2 / 5 / 7 / 14 / 30 Days based on your preference.

#### **News Notification**

AAT Company News notifications will give you updates on news and service enhancement announcements of AAT from time to time. The default setting would be “ON” and you may switch to “OFF” based on your preference.

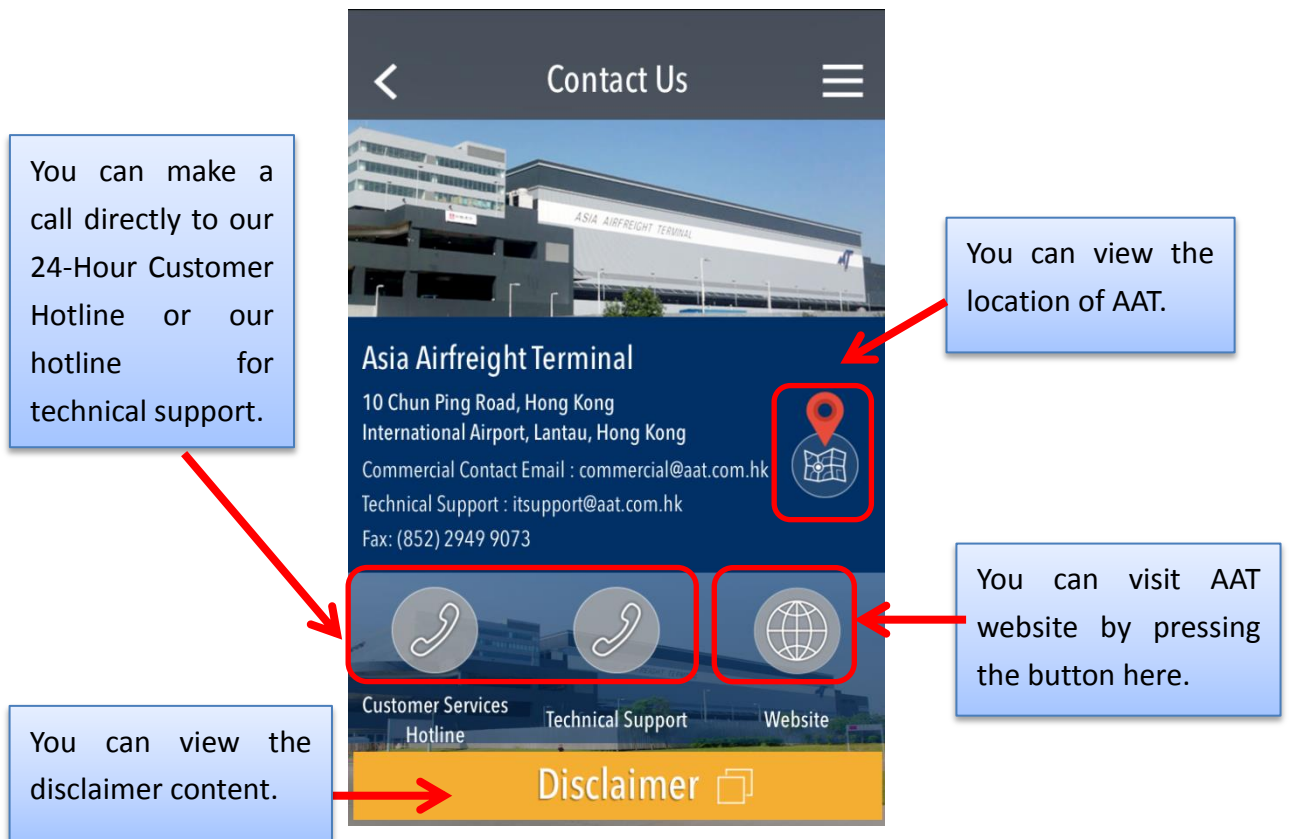

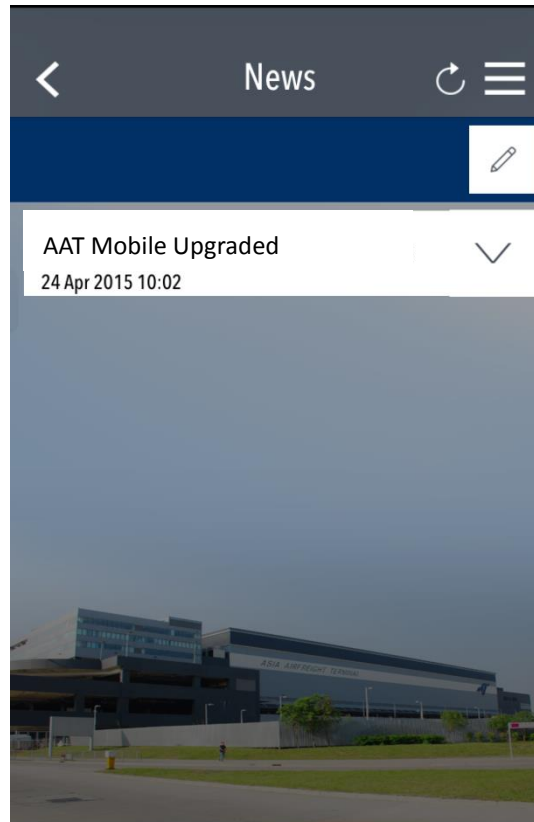
