Freight Forwarders and Warehouse Handlers (Operators & Handling Agent) personnel responsible for processing or accepting goods presented as general cargo and handling cargo in a warehouse, loading and unloading ULD, who have completed the Initial or Refresher course within a period of 24 months.

- ✓ Identify the general information about the dangerous goods classes and divisions
- ✓ Recognize the basic marking and labeling requirements
- ✓ Recognize Shipper's declaration and other documentation
- Reporting dangerous goods accidents, incidents, undeclared, mis-declared and occurrences
